

A review of all current subgrantee fiscal year 2022 allocations was done to improve and maximize the financial sustainability of the 21st Century program as well as to distribute resources amongst our subgrantees as equitably as possible given the rising need for Out of School Time (OST) programming across our state. Allocation adjustments were not made lightly and considered several factors, including but not limited to, spenddown of FY 2022 allocation, actual student participation data in CAYEN in contrast to the proposed number of students to be served in the funding application, and overall stewardship of the 21st Century grant.

We understand these decisions have consequences and are continually exploring additional avenues to address budget gaps that may result. Depending on the scope of your program, you may be eligible to apply for the College and Career Readiness Notice of Funding Opportunity available now [here](#). There are other strategies to alleviate budgetary concerns such as, moving sites between different cohorts, adjusting funds to sites based on student participation, partnering with community organizations for donations, exploring match funding as stipulated in ESSA section 4202. Your designated Education Programs Professional can support with answering questions and strategizing next steps, as necessary.

The allocation will be reflected in ePAGE under fiscal year 2023 shortly. Please complete your data, narrative and budget in ePAGE by May 31 for use of funds by July 1, 2022. We will review the applications on a rolling basis.
