

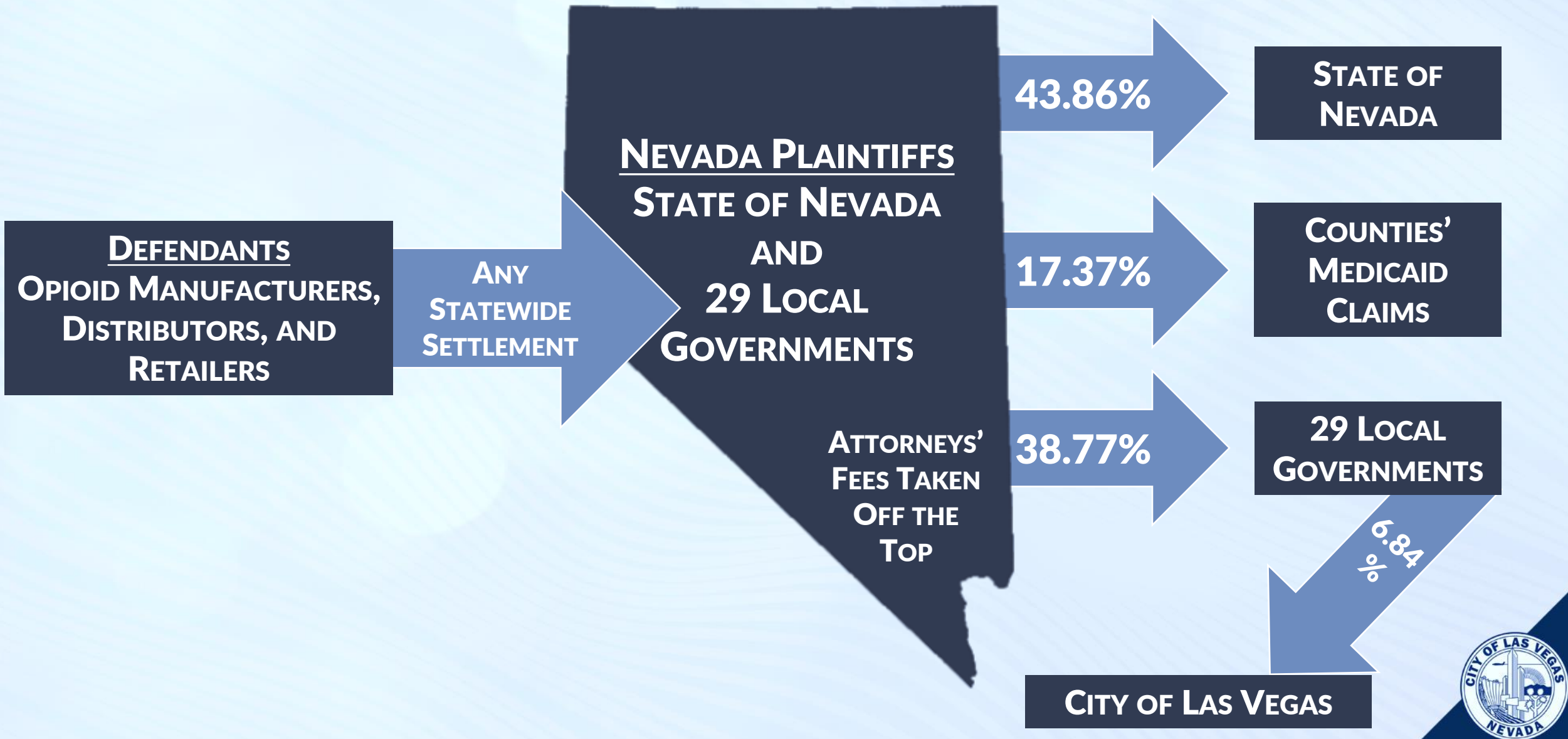

## **PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS TO:**

- **EXPAND ACCESS TO EVIDENCE-BASED PREVENTION OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS**
- **EARLY INTERVENTION FOR PERSONS AT RISK OF A SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER**
- **TREATMENT FOR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS**
- **SUPPORT FOR PERSONS IN RECOVERY FROM SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS**
- **REDUCE THE INCIDENCE AND SEVERITY OF NEONATAL ABSTINENCE SYNDROME**
- **PREVENT INCIDENTS OF ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES**
- **INCREASE EARLY INTERVENTION FOR CHILDREN WHO HAVE UNDERGONE ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES AND THE FAMILIES OF SUCH CHILDREN**
- **REDUCE THE HARM CAUSED BY SUBSTANCE USE**
- **PREVENT AND TREAT INFECTIOUS DISEASES IN PERSONS WITH SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS**
