AUTHORITY: LVMC 2.46 (Ordinance #5206 Adopted 4-19-2000)
Per L.V.M.C. 2.49.010, a person is not eligible to serve on this board unless he or she is a resident of the City of Las Vegas

MEMBERS: 8 members appointed by the City Council.
Mayor nominates 2 persons for appointment residing in 2 different Wards
Each Councilmember nominates 1 person for appointment (Persons nominated must reside in Ward represented by Councilmember making nomination)
No member may serve concurrently on any other board or commission which is established by resolution or ordinance, other than one which may be established on a temporary basis only.

TERM: Serve for an uninterrupted period not longer than eight years (2 terms) (Term to be coterminous with City Councilmember, but may serve until a successor is appointed)
*In August of 2009, the City Attorney gave an opinion that members who have served two four-year terms and then had a break in service are eligible for reappointment.

NOTES: Must be a City Resident
