

RESOLUTION NO. R-28-2023

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF UP TO \$125,000 DOLLARS
TO JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF SOUTHERN NEVADA,
A NEVADA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, FOR CITY OF LAS VEGAS BIZTOWN
STOREFRONT AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO**

WHEREAS, Junior Achievement of Southern Nevada ("Grantee"), is a Nevada non-profit corporation established for educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, Grantee desires to provide the city of Las Vegas ("City") a standard storefront in the Junior Achievement BizTown at the Junior Achievement Inspiration Center of Southern Nevada ("Junior Achievement Storefront"); and

WHEREAS, in connection with the educational purposes of Grantee, the City Council desires to grant to Grantee \$125,000 dollars (the "Grant Funds") for use in connection with the City's sponsorship of the Junior Achievement storefront; and

WHEREAS, NRS 268.028 authorizes the governing body of a city to expend money for any purpose that will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City, including a grant to a non-profit organization created for educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, NRS 268.028 further provides that such a grant of money must be made by means of a resolution that specifies the purpose of the grant, the maximum amount to be expended from the grant, and any conditions or other limitations on the expenditure of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the City enters into the Partner Activation Agreement with Grantee, which will provide the grant funds, as described herein, subject to the conditions and other limitations described in this Resolution and as set forth in the Partner Activation Agreement, specifically for the use and benefit of Grantee for the Junior Achievement Storefront; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Grantee's proposed use of the Grant Funds will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city of Las Vegas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS to grant the total amount of \$125,000 to Grantee, a Nevada non-profit corporation, for the Junior Achievement Storefront.

1 RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Council authorizes the Mayor of the City to execute the
2 Partner Activation Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Grantee, which will provide for the grant
3 funds, as described herein, for the use and benefit of Grantee, and subject to the conditions and limitations as
4 set forth in the Partner Activation Agreement.
