Neighborhood Partners Fund

- ▶ The Neighborhood Partners Fund (NPF) Program encourages neighborhoods to take an active role in their neighborhoods by addressing one or more of the following:
 - Physical Improvements
 - Public Safety
 - Cultural
 - Recreational or
 - Educational Programing/Tutoring



Neighborhood Partners Fund

- ▶ The program grants up to \$5,000 to registered neighborhood groups (Neighborhood Associations and HOA's).
- ▶ The funds must be matched by the neighborhood through:
 - Cash
 - Volunteer labor
 - Donated supplies/equipment
 - Professional services (pro-bono)



Neighborhood Partners Fund

- ▶ This year, the NPF Board is recommending:
 - **13** neighborhood projects
 - Total allocation of **\$57,679.87**
 - Total match of **\$75,870.90**

NPF Board

- ▶ Consists of 13 members appointed by the Mayor and Council.
- ▶ Evaluates projects and makes funding recommendations to the Mayor and City Council.







