Bill No. 2021-32 - Amends LVMC Chapter 19.04 to add a new section to provide procedures and standards by which parklets and streateries may be established within public rights-of-way and adjacent to public sidewalks in order to provide certain amenities, and amends LVMC Chapter 19.18 to provide corresponding definitions. PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will amend LVMC Chapter 19.04 to add a new section to provide procedures and standards by which parklets and streateries may be established within public rights-of-way and adjacent to public sidewalks in order to provide certain amenities. The bill will also amend LVMC Chapter 19.18 to provide corresponding definitions. The concept of parklets and streateries has been received well in other areas of the country and is consistent with operations that have been permitted temporarily within the City.
