**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The Neighborhood Partners Fund (NPF) Program was designed to encourage neighborhoods to take an active role in improving the quality of life in city of Las Vegas neighborhoods by enhancing the physical, public safety, cultural, recreational or educational conditions of a neighborhood. The program grants up to \$5,000 to registered neighborhood groups (neighborhood associations and HOA's). This year's NPF project allocation of \$39,142.30 will leverage a community match of \$65,603.80 in volunteer labor, in-kind donations of goods and services and/or financial contributions.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Neighborhood Partners Fund Board recommends that the City Council approve the funding for 11 neighborhood projects totaling \$39,142.30 and authorizes the Director of the Office of Community Services to execute the agreements upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.
