Report by Doug Cannon, President and CEO of NV Energy, concerning an update on the reliability of available electricity, renewable energy and energy conservation programs, and actions customers can take to save electricity and money - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Demand for electricity in the southwest increases during summer months and is critical to the health and well-being of residents and visitors to the region. Power companies face many challenges including regulatory changes, climate change, increased demand, and regional energy market supply. These challenges have raised questions about reliability of electricity to customers. This report presents current conditions, projected outcomes, and actions outlined in NV Energy's Integrated Resource Plan. The actions discussed in this report are needed to meet the demand for electricity in summer months, conservation objectives pursuant to the City's Master Plan and Nevada Energy's broader strategies of conserving electricity and securing power from renewable resources as Las Vegas continues to grow and develop.
