PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

A funding request in the amount of \$165,168 was approved by the Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial at the May 23, 2022 Commission Meeting for the costs associated with the planning and running of a four-day event titled, "Duck Duck Shed: Celebrating Las Vegas Architecture, Design, and Culture."

Between October 27 and 30, 2022, the Neon Museum will present "Duck Duck Shed: Celebrating Las Vegas Architecture, Design, and Culture." This four-day event will include walking tours, bus tours, a first-time home tour of Siegfried and Roy's Jungle Palace built in the City of Las Vegas in the 1970s, as well as a series of lectures, discussions and screenings related to the history of Las Vegas. The Museum will partner with key stakeholders and create original content to deliver programming that will further define the city as a cultural hub with major design and architectural influences that have world-wide effects, particularly in hospitality.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council approve the Commission's funding allocation to the Neon Museum in the amount of \$165,168 for the costs associated with the planning and running of a four-day event titled, "Duck Duck Shed: Celebrating Las Vegas Architecture, Design, and Culture."
