SUBJECT:

Hearing and discussion for possible action regarding a complaint for disciplinary action against J.L.F.L. Entertainment LLC d/b/a Club 2100, and Francisco Lara, Managing Member, whose place of business is located at 2100 Fremont Street, Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, 89101 as holders of Nightclub License No. D19-00012, Tavern License No. L16-00390, Tobacco License No. C05-02873, Tobacco Establishment License No. P63-00082, and Automated Teller Machine License No. G64-03989 for violations of the Las Vegas Municipal Code - Ward 3 (Diaz)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Between December 20, 2020 and January 23, 2022, there have been numerous calls for service, violent incidents, assaults, batteries, firearm issues, underage drinking, gang-related activity, and a homicide-kidnapping connected to the operation of the Club 2100. Despite numerous warnings and fines, both to the current and previous owners of this club, the violent criminal activity and security issues have continued at this location. The City now seeks disciplinary action by the City Council under LVMC 6.02.330 for the continued operation of this business as a dangerous and chronic nuisance to the health, safety and well-being of the community.

Revocation of all licenses
