## SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve Interlocal Contract LLD31A22 between the City of Las Vegas (CLV) and the Clark County Regional Flood Control District (CCRFCD) for the construction of the Local Drainage Improvements - El Capitan Storm Drain Project (\$1,650,479 - Road and Flood Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - Ward 6 (Fiore)

## PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The El Capitan storm drain improvements is a local drainage project that was submitted to the CCRFCD on April 15, 2022. The project complies with the CCRFCD's policies for local drainage projects and has staff approval for funding. The project is located within the upper northern of the CCRFCD master plan and is within a portion of the Las Vegas Wash - Moccasin Conveyance System drainage area. The project is located in El Capitan Way between Ruston Road and Moccasin Road. This proposed local drainage participation project will construct a various size storm drain pipe from 54-inch Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) to 72-inch RCP storm drain system that will help reduce flooding, eliminate the flood damage to homes and reduce other maintenance issues that result from storm events in this neighborhood. The proposed facilities will connect into the existing regional drainage facility in Moccasin Road (LVMO 0001). The CCRFCD approved this contract at their July 14, 2022 board meeting.
