Report by Steve Ford, Director, Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Rachel Bergren, Executive Director of Get Outdoors Nevada, and Almendra Johnson, Volunteer Program Director on the volunteer activities at the Las Vegas Healing Garden, located at 1015 South Casino Center Boulevard, and the Volunteer in Parks program, which is an engagement program of volunteers in parks throughout the City of Las Vegas parks system - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City's Park and Trail Assistance Program Agreement with Get Outdoors Nevada provides a Volunteer In Parks (VIP) program that arranges 18 park clean-up or tree planting events throughout all six wards, coordinates youth programming activities and education, as well as the construction of one Native Habitat Garden in the City of Las Vegas, which will be determined. The agreement also calls for two maintenance events hosted at the Las Vegas Healing Garden; one in the fall in preparation for October 1 memorial and one in the spring. Get Outdoors Nevada will also host one volunteer appreciation events at the end of each term in June.
