#### SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve Interlocal Contract 1064 - Supplemental No. 2 between the City of Las Vegas (CLV), Clark County, and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) to increase funding for a design of a pedestrian bridge at the intersection of Sahara Avenue and Las Vegas Boulevard (\$4,450,000 - Traffic Improvements Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - Ward 3 (Diaz) and Clark County

## PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The RTC approved Interlocal Contract 1064 to provide funding for the Pedestrian Bridge, Intersection at Sahara Avenue and Las Vegas Boulevard Project. This Supplemental No. 2 will provide additional funds to cover NV Energy transmission relocation and the design consultant agreement to move from 70 percent to final design of the bridge. The project is administered by the CLV in coordination with Clark County Public Works and is on the RTC's adopted Transportation Investment Business Plan (TIBP). Total funding for the project from the Highway Improvement Acquisition Fund shall not exceed \$7,450,000, as noted in the contract. The RTC approved this contract at their September 8, 2022 board meeting.
