## SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve the installation of speed cushions on Via Olivero Avenue between Buffalo Drive and Rainbow Boulevard (\$36,000 - Traffic Improvements Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - Ward 1 (Knudsen)

#### PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Engineering Division of the City of Las Vegas (CLV) met with residents in the Buffalo Coalition Neighborhood in April 2021 to discuss various traffic concerns. In response to the concerns, a comprehensive study reviewing traffic volumes, speeds, and crashes was conducted and this segment was found to be a candidate for the installation of speed cushions based on guidance from the Federal Highway Administration and Institute of Transportation Engineers. The CLV Fire Department will support this installation in accordance with the CLV Fire #6631 Traffic Calming Devices as long as they meet all required specifications set forth by the CLV. The Traffic and Parking Commission recommended approval of installing speed cushions on Via Olivero Avenue between Buffalo Drive and Rainbow Boulevard at their meeting on August 25, 2022. An initial installation of the speed cushions will be performed on Via Olivero Avenue from Buffalo Drive to Pioneer Way, with permanent installation for the entire limits to be included with a future CLV Capital Improvement Project.
