SUBJECT:

ABEYANCE ITEM - For possible action to approve continued funding in an amount not to exceed \$2 million in FY23 for Leonard Law, McDonald Carano, and Shute, Mihaly & Weinberger to represent the City of Las Vegas in all matters arising in the Badlands litigation, which involves the former Badlands Golf Course generally located south of Alta Drive, east of Hualapai Way, and north of Charleston Boulevard (General Fund) - Ward 2 (Seaman)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

180 Land Company, LLC and Fore Stars, Ltd., have filed multiple lawsuits against the City stemming from requests to redevelop portions of the former Badlands golf course. The cases have now progressed to various stages, including the discovery phase, pre-trial, and review on appeal. In these matters, the City is represented by the City Attorney's Office and three retained, outside law firms: Leonard Law (Reno), McDonald Carano (Las Vegas), and Shute, Mihaly & Weinberger (San Francisco). The City Council approved \$2 million for Badlands outside counsel in the FY23 budget at its May 18, 2022 meeting. This item is approve the disbursement of that \$2 million by the Department of Finance to the three retained, outside law firms, as needed, based upon periodic engagement letters from the outside law firms sent to the City Attorney's Office, reviewed by the City Attorney's Office, and signed by the City Manager.
