Discussion for possible action regarding the appointment of Michael Cunningham to the Building and Safety Enterprise Fund Advisory Committee

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

### PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Nevada Revised Statues (NRS) 354.59891 and Senate Bill No. 184 state that local governments that create an enterprise fund shall establish an advisory committee to review the operation of and make recommendations relating to the enterprise fund. The committee consists of five members to represent the residential construction industry, the commercial development industry, the construction industry, a public officer of the City who manages the fiscal affairs of the City, and a public officer of the Department of Building and Safety who oversees directly the operation of the enterprise fund. Appointments to the Committee shall be approved by the City Council. Terms are for two years, with no limit to the number of terms, and there is no City Residency requirement. Due to the retirement of Kevin McOsker, the seat reserved for a Public Officer who oversees directly the Enterprise Fund is vacant. As the Deputy Building and Safety Director, Mr. Cunningham's appointment is appropriate.
