Discussion for possible action to rename Harris Marion Park to the Arroyo Vista Park, located at 4755 Harris Avenue - Ward 3 (Diaz)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

At the October 4, 2022, Parks and Recreation (P&R) Advisory Commission Meeting, it was unanimously recommended to re-name Harris Marion Park to Arroyo Vista Park.

Harris Marion Park is adjacent to a neighborhood called Happy Valley and is just south of Robison Middle School on Harris Street. The updated park will include a sports field, playground, and an equestrian riding rink for families in the area who have horses.

The new proposed name is "Arroyo Vista" Park because of its close proximity to the Las Vegas Wash. "Arroyo" in Spanish signifies a stream of water or a channel of water, very much like the Las Vegas wash in this area. "Vista" signifies scene, view, or panorama. The name of the park was determined by the following methods; a survey of nearby residents to collect suggestions, residents were invited to e-mail suggestions, and the neighborhood was canvassed to collect feedback. The Ward 3 office then selected the name after considering all suggestions.
