(Not-to-Exceed \$3,300,849 - Fire Fleet Apparatus / Equipment Replacement Capital Projects Fund) - All Wards

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The contract provides for the purchase of nine (9) ambulances (a.k.a. Rescues). This item is exempt from competitive bidding per NRS 332.115 (d), equipment which, by reason of the training of the personnel or of an inventory of replacement parts maintained by the local government, is compatible with existing equipment, and NRS 332. 195, joinder or mutual use of contracts by governmental entities. The contract joins the Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments (H-GAC) Contract No. AM 10-20, which resulted from a competitive bid. Hughes Fire Equipment, Inc. is located in Springfield, Oregon.

Approve as recommended, with signature authority granted to the Purchasing and Contracts Manager per R-20-2017.
