Report by the Department of Community Development staff regarding the City of Las Vegas Historic Resource Survey Catalog and the creation of maps illustrating areas of the city that have been surveyed for historic resources - All Wards

FISCAL IMPACT:

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On January 28, 2020, the Department of Planning (now Community Development) submitted a grant proposal to the State Historic Preservation Office's (SHPO) Historic Preservation Fund Subgrant Program. The proposal requested funding to hire a Cultural Resource Management Firm to conduct a detailed review of historic property surveys previously conducted within the city of Las Vegas and create a Historic Resource Survey Catalog. That proposal resulted in a grant award on July 7, 2020 in the amount of \$30,000.00.

Nevada Preservation Foundation was hired to complete the project that began in December 2020 and completed in March 2022. The research resulted in a catalog containing 120 surreys dating between 1970 and 2021 from governmental and non-governmental agencies. Data from the catalog was extracted in order to create a series of maps that illustrate areas of the city that have and have not been surveyed for historic resources. The information in the catalog and maps demonstrate that large areas of historic aged resources still require investigation in order to determine eligibility for listing on the National Register of Historic Places and the Las Vegas Historic Property Register.
