RA-7-2022 - Discussion for possible action regarding a Resolution finding the project proposed by the Multifamily Residential Visual Improvement Program (MFR-VIP) Agreement between the City of Las Vegas Redevelopment Agency (RDA) and 1410 S Casino Center LLC and 1416 S Casino Center LLC, located at 1410 and 1416 South Casino Center Boulevard (APN's 162-03-210-044 and -045), to be in compliance with and in furtherance of the goals and objectives of the Redevelopment Plan and authorizing the execution of the MFR-VIP Agreement by the RDA (Not-to-Exceed \$25,000 - RDA Special Revenue Fund) - Redevelopment Area - Ward 3 (Diaz)

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

1410 S Casino Center LLC and 1416 Casino Center LLC will undertake improvements to the property located at 1410 and 1416 South Casino Center Boulevard. This project is currently an old closed down, dilapidated 28 unit, two building apartment complex, located on two adjoining parcels under common ownership. The apartment units are currently inhabitable and stripped down for remodeling. This MFR-VIP Agreement will assist with the cost of improvements. Approval will adopt findings that the MFR-VIP is in compliance with and furtherance of the goals and objectives of the RDA and the Redevelopment Plan.
