**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

A funding request in the amount of \$185,000 was approved by the Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial at the November 28, 2022 Commission Meeting for the costs associated with planning and running of the "Home + History 2023" Event.

In 2014, the Nevada Preservation Foundation started a Vintage Vegas Home Tour, an afternoon of historic open houses, which over the course of five-years, transformed into a three-day event called "Home + History Las Vegas" (HHLV). HHLV celebrates Nevada's captivating history by fostering an appreciation of historic and important architecture in the Las Vegas Valley. By creating a fun and engaging series of events, HHLV promotes, educates and advocates for the preservation of Las Vegas' architectural resources, as well as breeds renewed interest in preservation, urban sustainability, and community development. "Home + History 2023" Event will take place between April 27 and April 30, 2023.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that City Council approve the Commission's funding allocation for the planning and running of the "Home + History 2023" Event in the amount of \$185,000.
