**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This bill will amend LVMC Chapter 7.40, regarding professional animal handler and breeder permits, to expand the scope of the permit requirement to include animal rescue operations, require background checks, and establish additional operational requirements for the holders of certain permits. Such additional requirements include the posting of signage and the reporting of certain types of animal injuries and deaths.
