SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve the City of Las Vegas HOME-ARP Allocation Plan (performance period ending September 30, 2030), which is part of the 2021 American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and will address the need for homelessness assistance and supportive services for our community's qualifying populations - All Wards

FISCAL IMPACT:

None

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

As part of the 2021 American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), the City of Las Vegas has been awarded \$8,289,072 of HOME-ARP funds to address the need for homelessness assistance and supportive services for our community's qualifying populations. In order to receive federal funds for homeless and housing programs and services, the City of Las Vegas must submit a HOME-ARP Allocation Plan to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) no later than March 31, 2023. The Allocation Plan discusses planned efforts by the City of Las Vegas for the period ending September 30, 2030 and will become final upon HUD's approval. Funding sources include HOME-ARP funds from HUD. The City of Las Vegas will comply with all HUD required policies and guidelines in the administration of the funds.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the City of Las Vegas HUD HOME-ARP Allocation Plan and authorize the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Services to adjust awards if allocations are reduced/increased by HUD and to award unallocated funds and redistribute funds that are recaptured.
