Discussion for possible action regarding the appointment of nominee Bonnie Swadling to the Ward 3 seats of the Traffic and Parking Commission and the Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Commission

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**  
The members of the Traffic & Parking Commission are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council such that one member shall reside in and represent each of the six Wards and one member shall represent the City as a whole. Terms are four years; there is no requirement to fill unexpired portions of terms and no limit to the number of terms which may be served. Ms. Kathleen Kahr occupied the Ward 3 resident seat and her term expired.

The Traffic Signal Capital Improvements Advisory Committee was created by NRS 278B.150, specifically by R-121-2002, adopted by the City Council on November 6, 2002. The committee consists of 9 members, with 2 or more members representing Residential and Commercial Building Industries. There are no term limits; each member serves until replaced by City Council action. Any member of the City Council may make a recommendation to fill this seat however it is usually done in conjunction with the replacement of a Ward specific seat on the Traffic & Parking Commission. Max Carter was originally appointed to the Ward 3 seat on this board on August 6, 2014.

**RECOMMENDATION:**  
Options are: Appoint Ms. Swadling to one or both boards or, direct staff to bring forward an item(s) to a future meeting to appoint nominees to serve in these seats.
