RECOMMENDING COMMITTEE: BILLS ELIGIBLE FOR ADOPTION AT A LATER MEETING

Bill No. 2023-6 - Amends LVMC Chapter 7.40, regarding professional animal handler and breeder permits, to expand the scope of the permit requirement to include animal rescue operations, establish additional operational requirements for the holders of certain permits, and provide minimum penalties for certain violations. Sponsored by: Councilwoman Victoria Seaman

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill is a follow-up to Bill No. 2022-26, recently considered by the City Council but not adopted. This bill will amend LVMC Chapter 7.40, regarding professional animal handler and breeder permits, to expand the scope of the permit requirement to include animal rescue operations, establish additional operational requirements for the holders of certain permits, and provide minimum penalties for certain violations. The additional permit-related requirements include the posting of signage and the reporting of certain types of animal injuries and deaths. This bill does not include the background check requirements that were included in Bill No. 2022-26.
