For possible action to approve Interlocal Contract 3091 between the City of Las Vegas (CLV) and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) to provide funding for the implementation of the CLV Vision Zero Program (\$1,250,000 - Traffic Improvements Capital Project Fund [CPF]) - All Wards

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The CLV has requested funding for the implementation of the CLV Vision Zero Program. The City Council adopted the CLV's Vision Zero Action Plan on February 1, 2023, via Resolution No. R-4-2023, in which we identified the goal of eliminating all traffic fatalities and severe injuries by the year 2050, while increasing safe, healthy, and equitable mobility for all. The Action Plan has been developed over several years by CLV staff in cooperation with our peer/partner agencies, safety stakeholders, and the public to address the complexities associated with fatal and serious injury crashes. This project will include the implementation of over 90 actions among five key strategies to continue to improve transportation safety throughout the city and southern Nevada. Total funding for the project from the Highway Improvement Fund shall not exceed \$1,250,000, as noted in the contract. The RTC approved this contract at their March 9, 2023 board meeting.
