RECOMMENDING COMMITTEE: BILLS ELIGIBLE FOR ADOPTION AT THIS MEETING

Bill No. 2023-10 - For possible action - Repeals LVMC 2.44.050, relating to the minimum number of regular monthly meetings to be held by the Planning Commission. Proposed by: Jorge Cervantes, City Manager

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will repeal LVMC 2.44.050, relating to the minimum number of regular monthly meetings to be held by the Planning Commission. The default requirement for a planning commission under State law is at least one regular meeting a month. Several years ago the City Council determined to require at least two regular Planning Commission meetings per month based on the volume of Commission business at that time. It has been determined that the default requirement of at least one meeting a month is sufficient at this time. Repeal of the Code section will put back into play the statutory default of at least one regular meeting a month, with the ability to establish additional meetings if desired.
