SUBJECT:

For possible action to approve an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Clark County, Nevada designating the County as the applicant and fiscal agent for purposes of administering the FFY2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program in the amount of \$840,615, with an allocation to the City of Las Vegas in the amount of \$33,500 for the Performing and Visual Arts Summer Camp for Kids Program at the West Las Vegas Arts Center, located at 947 West Lake Mead Boulevard - Ward 5 (Crear)

FISCAL IMPACT:

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City of Las Vegas and Clark County, Nevada (NV) are the recipients of funds offered by the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program. The grant provides funding for a range of program areas that support all components of the criminal justice system. This annual grant has historically been received for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs programs, as well as, programs in other departments. The Interlocal Agreement identifies Clark County, NV as the applicant/fiscal agent for the \$840,615 JAG grant award. The City of Las Vegas recommended allocations are \$30,000 to fund the West Las Vegas Arts Center Performing and Visual Art Summer Camp for Kids Program, and \$3,500 for the administration of the FFY2022 JAG grant by our Finance Department. The total recommended funding allocation for the City of Las Vegas is \$33,500 with the remaining funding of \$807,115 allocated to Clark County, NV.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Interlocal Agreement authorizes the Mayor to execute any and all documents related following approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
