R-29-2023 - Discussion for possible action regarding a Resolution adopting a plan for outdoor recreation along the Desert Edge of the City of Las Vegas

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The western and northwestern "desert edge" open space areas within and immediately adjacent to the City contain ample natural public lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management that allow for outdoor recreation opportunities, such as hiking, mountain biking, mountain climbing, and equestrian activities. Population growth has also resulted in impacts on natural areas in the Kyle Canyon, La Madre Foothills, Nu Wav Kaiv, and Tule Springs as identified in the City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan. The City intends to balance increased outdoor recreation activities with development in these areas, including trail and park development alongside context sensitive development. If adopted, the resolution summarizes, reaffirms, and links together these official commitments. Broadly summarized, this resolution reaffirms policy goals in the City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan, defines outdoor recreation, and directs staff to work with other state and Federal agencies on funding opportunities for outdoor recreation and reserving land for parks and open space areas in connection with the implementation of the Imagine Las Vegas Parks System Plan (23-0092-GPA1) of the City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan.
