**SUBJECT:**

For possible action to approve the Planting Partner Agreement between the City of Las Vegas (City) and One Tree Planted which grants the City a \$50,000 award to implement the Nevada 2023 - East Las Vegas "Tree-Bate" Program to plant trees within the East Las Vegas, Downtown Las Vegas, and West Las Vegas areas - Wards 3 and 5 (Diaz and Crear)

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan's urban forestry goal and Urban Forestry Program (R-43-2022) contains an outcome and implementation strategies for the planting and maintenance of 60,000 diverse and high quality native and adaptive trees on public and private property by 2050. In February 2023, the city submitted an urban forestry grant funding project proposal to One Tree Planted, a national non-profit organization that supports communities to plant trees at locations where need is greatest. The organization addresses environmental justice issues and helps communities achieve tree and equity goals, so community members have access to the benefits of trees as well as equitable access to resources needed to plant and sustain them. The proposed "Tree-Bate" Program will focus on planting 250 trees on private property in neighborhoods most affected by the urban heat island effect, primarily within the East Las Vegas, Downtown Las Vegas, and West Las Vegas areas. The city will provide the trees from the city nursery and work with other grant partners on activities specified in the agreement. Grant funds will be expended on a "Tree-Bate" for the planting of trees, connection of irrigation, and monitoring trees for up to three (3) years.
