**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The City of Las Vegas anticipates utilizing \$3,537,887 of United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOPWA Funding for FY 2023-2024 to benefit low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families. The City of Las Vegas shall complete all HUD-Required Environmental Reviews (ER). No project may commit and/or expend any funds prior to compliance with 24 CFR Part 58 and final notification and execution of the HUD Agreements.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of the HOPWA allocations and authorization of the Mayor to execute any and all related agreements and documents required for the projects following approval as to form by the City Attorney. Staff also recommends the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Services be authorized to execute documents related to the award of unallocated funds and reprogram unspent funds in the event that funds are recaptured
