For possible action to approve a host site agreement between the City of Las Vegas and FORTH as part of the "Affordable Mobility Platform" to implement community carsharing as part of a grant subaward from the US Department of Energy - Wards 1 and 5 (Knudsen and Crear)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Forth, an Oregon-based nonprofit corporation, is the prime recipient of the U.S. Department of Energy grant for Low Greenhouse Gas Vehicle Technologies Research, Development, Demonstration and Deployment (DE-EE0009864), and leads a consortium of cities across eight states to deploy a replicable and affordable clean transportation program within underserved communities. The project, the Affordable Mobility Platform (AMP), is a community car sharing program providing electric vehicles to residents in affordable locations with the goal of increasing access to clean transportation by making low-cost electric vehicles available in underserved communities. As part of this pilot project, the City will host AMP electric vehicles and electric vehicle charging stations funded through NV Energy's Economic Recovery Transportation Electrification Plan at Mirabelli Community Center and Doolittle Community Center. Through an application on the participant's phone, participants may share cars for short-term rental to use for errands, shopping and/or appointments.
