Discussion for possible action regarding the reappointment of Robert Potter and the appointment of nominee Vincent Tatum to the Building and Safety Enterprise Fund Advisory Committee

FISCAL IMPACT:

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:
Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 354.59891 and Senate Bill No. 184 state that local governments that create an enterprise fund shall establish an advisory committee to review the operation of and make recommendations relating to the enterprise fund. The committee consists of five members to represent the residential construction industry, the commercial development industry, the construction industry, a public officer of the City who manages the fiscal affairs of the City, and a public officer of the Department of Building and Safety who oversees directly the operation of the enterprise fund. Appointments to the Committee shall be approved by the City Council. Terms are for two years, with no limit to the number of terms, and there is no City Residency requirement. Mr. Potter represents the Commercial Development Industry and has served since 2008. He is eligible and wishes to be reappointed. If appointed, Mr. Tatum would fill the seat reserved for a representative of the Construction Industry, which was previously occupied by Stephen Quinn since 2006. Mr. Quinn no longer wishes to serve. Mr. Potter and Mr. Tatum have the recommendation of the Building and Safety Director.

RECOMMENDATION:
Options are: Reappoint Mr. Potter and/or Appoint Mr. Tatum or instruct staff to bring forward an item to a future Council meeting to consider other nominees.
