For possible action to approve Amendment No. 2 to the Franchise Agreement for Ambulance Services between the City of Las Vegas and Mercy, Inc. dba American Medical Response (AMR), which provides for an extension on services until January 28, 2021 - All Wards

FISCAL IMPACT:

None

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On September 3, 2014, the City and AMR entered into a five (5) year Franchise Agreement for emergency ambulance services. The Franchise Agreement commenced on December 1, 2015 and expires on December 1, 2020. The Franchise Agreement provides for two possible extensions, the first of which may be granted for a period of no more than three (3) years. The Franchise Agreement requires AMR to submit a request for extension to the City Manager not less than one (1) calendar year prior to expiration. In 2019, AMR timely submitted a request to extend the Franchise Agreement for three (3) years. The City and AMR have been negotiating the terms of the first extension of the Franchise Agreement as directed by the City Manager. This extension of the Franchise Agreement to January 28, 2021 will allow the City and AMR the additional time needed to complete those negotiations and obtain City Council approval of a related Ordinance amendment.
