DISCUSSION

SUBJECT:

Discussion for possible action regarding a complaint and to set a hearing date for disciplinary action against Soul of Afrika Corp. and Eudora Mordi-Ozigbu, President, whose place of business is located at 1750 South Rainbow Boulevard, #8, Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, 89146 as holders of Beer Wine Cooler On-Sale License No. P66-00345/L68-00029, Restaurant License No. G66-06515, Tobacco Sales/Lounge License No. P67-00167, and Tobacco Dealer License No. G67-04516 for violations of the Las Vegas Municipal Code - Ward 1 (Knudsen)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Since receiving its restaurant license on October 4, 2018, Beer Wine On-Sale License on December 19, 2018, Tobacco Sales/Lounge License on August 8, 2019, and Tobacco Dealer License on August 20, 2020, Soul of Afrika and Eudora Mordi-Ozigbu (its owner and sole shareholder) have engaged in repeated unapproved nightclub activity, including but not limited to DJ parties advertised on social media, even though the business is licensed only as a restaurant. These activities have led to regular unlicensed activities at the business, one of which led to a shooting in the parking lot of the business. As a result of this activity, as well as the licensees' lack of cooperation and compliance, a public nuisance and safety issue has been created by the licensees, all in violation of the laws of the State of Nevada and the Las Vegas Municipal Code.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council issue the Complaint for Disciplinary Action and set a date and time certain for hearing no later than 60 days from the date of approval of the complaint.
