**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

A previous ordinance and resolution authorized temporary measures and programs allowing certain types of businesses with an alcoholic beverage license and a restaurant license to offer and provide the delivery, curbside pick-up, or take-out of alcoholic beverages in connection with the delivery, pick-up, or take-out of food by a person who has placed an order therefor. Those measures and programs expire by limitation at the end of this year. This Resolution will extend them until the earliest of July 1, 2021, the cessation of the City's Declaration of Emergency, or the adoption of an ordinance codifying the measures or programs.
